"FOUR SIGNS OF COUNTERCULTURITES" NEW BEGINNING COMMUNITY CHURCH DR. R. GARY ASHLEY SEPTEMBER 22, 2024

- I.T.: #1: Moses received the <u>TEN</u> Commandment on a Mountain and Jesus preached the <u>SERMON</u> on the Mount on a Mountain.
- I.T.: #2: The first <u>FOUR</u> commands have to do with vertical relationship and the last <u>SIX</u> have to do with our horizonal relationships.
- I.T.: #3: The first <u>FOUR</u> Beatitudes reveal how to be saved, the last <u>FOUR</u> reveal the Signs of Salvation.
- I.T. #4: The four steps of salvation are awareness of <u>SINS</u>, deep sorrow for <u>SINNING</u>, a turning away from a life rebellion to living a life of <u>REBELLION</u>, and a <u>CHANGED</u> life.

Matthew 5:7–12 <u>God blesses those who are merciful</u>, for they will be shown mercy. ⁸ <u>God blesses those whose hearts are pure</u>, for they will see God. ⁹ <u>God blesses those who work for peace</u>, for they will be called the children of God. ¹⁰ <u>God blesses those who are persecuted for doing right</u>, for the Kingdom of Heaven is theirs. ¹¹ "God blesses you when people mock you and persecute you and lie about you and say all sorts of evil things against you because you are my followers. ¹² Be happy about it! Be very glad! For a great reward awaits you in heaven. And remember, the ancient prophets were persecuted in the same way.

FOUR SIGNS

I. COUNTERCULTURITES ARE MERCIFUL PEOPLE.

Matthew 5:7 God blesses those who are merciful, for they will be shown mercy.

Merciful: a person who shows leniency, compassion, or forgiveness; especially towards someone who has <u>OFFENDED</u> them.

- A. God extended mercy to us when he <u>SAVED</u> us. Ephesians 2:4-5 <u>But God is</u> so rich in mercy, and he loved us so much, ⁵ that even though we were dead because of our sins, he gave us life when he raised Christ from the dead. (It is only by God's grace that you have been saved!)
- B. Once we receive mercy, we are to be <u>EXTENDERS</u> of mercy. Galatians 6:16 May God's <u>peace and mercy</u> be upon all <u>who live by this principle</u>; they are the new people of God.
 - K.T.: Before salvation, we were extenders of <u>WRATH</u>; after salvation, we become extenders of MERCY!
- C. We needed mercy in the past and we will need mercy in the <u>FUTURE</u>. Matthew 5:7 *God blesses those who are merciful, for they will be shown mercy*.
- D. Merciful people are distribution centers for <u>MERCY</u>. Acts 10:38 Then Jesus <u>went around doing good</u> and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with him.
- E. Mercy is a <u>SURE</u> sign of salvation. Matthew 25:35–36 For I was hungry, and <u>you fed me</u>. I was thirsty, and <u>you gave me a drink</u>. I was a stranger, and <u>you invited me into your home</u>. ³⁶ I was naked, and <u>you gave me clothing</u>. I was sick, and <u>you cared for me</u>. I was in prison, and <u>you visited me</u>.'

II. COUNTERCULTURITES MAINTAIN A PURE HEART.

Matthew 5:8 God blesses those whose hearts are pure, for they will see God.

Pure heart: in a state of ritual cleanliness or <u>FREE</u> of guilt and sin.

- A. God gives us a pure heart at the moment of <u>SALVATION</u>. Romans 8:1 So now there is <u>no condemnation</u> for those who belong to Christ Jesus. Isaiah 1:18 Come now, let's settle this," says the LORD. "Though your sins are like scarlet, <u>I</u> <u>will make them as white as snow</u>. Though they are red like crimson, <u>I will make them as white as wool</u>.
- K.T.: The problem is that we live in a <u>DIRTY</u> world, and we must maintain a CLEAN heart.
- B. How do we maintain a <u>PURE</u> heart?
- 1. A pure heart must be our <u>GOAL</u>! Psalm 51:10 <u>Create in me a clean heart, O</u> God. Renew a loyal spirit within me.
- 2. Close out the day by praying for past <u>FAILURES!</u> Psalm 26:2 Put me <u>on trial</u>, LORD, and <u>cross-examine me</u>. <u>Test my motives and my heart</u>.
- 3. Begin the day by praying for future <u>VICTORIES</u>! Matthew 6:13 And don't let us <u>yield to temptation</u>, but rescue us from the evil one.

III. COUNTERCULTURITES ARE PEACEMAKERS.

Matthew 5:9 God blesses those who work for peace, for they will be called the children of God.

- A. <u>BEFORE</u> salvation, we were troublemakers; <u>AFTER</u> salvation we become peacemakers.
- B. Christians can have peace with GOD, SELF and OTHERS!
- C. Christians can have peace in the midst of the <u>STORMS</u> of life.
- D. Christians can be peacemakers between **GOD** and **MAN**.
- E. Christians can be peacemakers between MAN and MAN.

1 Peter 3:11 Search for peace, and work to maintain it.

Hebrews 12:14 WORK at living in peace with everyone. . .

Romans 12:18 If possible, so far as it depends on you, live peaceably with all.

IV. COUNTERCULTURITES ARE PERSECUTED.

Matthew 5:10–12 God blesses those who are <u>persecuted</u> for doing right, for the Kingdom of Heaven is theirs. ¹¹ "God blesses you when people <u>mock you and</u> <u>persecute you and lie about you and say all sorts of evil things against you</u> because you are my followers. ¹² <u>Be happy about it! Be very glad!</u> For a great reward awaits you in heaven. And remember, the ancient prophets were persecuted in the same way.

- A. The definition: the persecuted have a <u>TARGET</u> on their back.
- B. The attack: to mock is unjust <u>INSULTS</u>, to persecute is deliberate <u>HARM</u> and lies are FALSE accusations!
- C. The command: be exceedingly filled with <u>JOY</u>.
- D. The reason: Christians will be rewarded in HEAVEN for faithfulness.
- E. The example: The O.T. prophets set the STAGE.
