INTRO: To understand the Sermon on the Mount, we must <u>GRASP</u> the O.T. background!

## I. THE OLD TESTAMENT BACKGROUND.

- A. The <u>SETTING</u>. Exodus 19:3–6 Then Moses climbed the mountain to appear before God. The LORD called to him from the mountain and said, "Give these instructions to the family of Jacob; announce it to the descendants of Israel: <sup>4</sup> 'You have seen what I did to the Egyptians. You know how I carried you on eagles' wings and brought you to myself. <sup>5</sup> Now if you will obey me and keep my covenant, you will be my own special treasure from among all the peoples on earth; for all the earth belongs to me. <sup>6</sup> And you will be my kingdom of priests, my holy nation.' This is the message you must give to the people of Israel."
- B. The <u>COMMAND</u>. Leviticus 18:1–4 Then the LORD said to Moses, <sup>2</sup> "Give the following instructions to the people of Israel. I am the LORD your God. <sup>3</sup> So do not act like the people in Egypt, where you used to live, or like the people of Canaan, where I am taking you. You must not imitate their way of life. <sup>4</sup> You must obey all my regulations and be careful to obey my decrees, for I am the LORD your God.
- C. The people's <u>RESPONSE</u>. Exodus 24:7 Then he took the Book of the Covenant and read it aloud to the people. Again they all responded, "<u>We will do everything</u> the LORD has commanded. We will obey."
- D. The <u>RESULTS</u>. Psalm 106:35 Instead, they mingled among the pagans and adopted their evil customs. 1 Samuel 8:5 "Look," they told him, "you are now old, and your sons are not like you. Give us a king to judge us like all the other nations have."
  - Ezekiel 20:32 "You say, 'We want to be like the nations all around us, who serve idols of wood and stone.'
- E. The <u>WARNINGS</u>. Jeremiah 10:2 This is what the LORD says: "<u>Do not act like</u> the other nations, who try to read their future in the stars. . ."

  Ezekiel 20:7 Then I said to them, 'Each of you, get rid of the vile images you are so obsessed with. <u>Do not defile yourselves with the idols of Egypt</u>, for I am the LORD your God.'
- F. The **CONSEQUENCE**.
- 1. In <u>722-23</u> B.C., the Assyrians destroyed the Northern Kingdom.
- 2. In <u>596</u> B.C., the Babylonians destroyed the Southern Kingdom.
- 3. In A.D. <u>33</u> ish, Jesus took the Kingdom away from Israel.

  Matthew 21:43 I tell you, the Kingdom of God will be taken away from you and given to a nation that will produce the proper fruit.
- 4. In A.D. <u>70</u>, the Romans destroyed Jerusalem putting the final nail in Israel's coffin.

G. The <u>EXAMPLE</u>. 1 Corinthians 10:11 These things happened to them as examples for us. They were written down TO WARN us who live at the end of the age.

Super duper truth on steriods<sup>2</sup>: The same thing that happen to Israel will happen to a Christian or a church that <u>FOLLOW</u> Israel's example.

## II. THE NEW TESTAMENT COUNTERPART.

- A. The <u>SETTING</u>. **Matthew 5:1** *One day as he saw the crowds gathering, Jesus went up on the mountainside and sat down.*
- K.T.: God gave the Law through Moses; God gave them Sermon on the Mount through HIMSELF.
- B. The <u>AUDIENCE</u>. Matthew 5:1–2 <u>His disciples gathered around him</u>, <sup>2</sup> and he began to teach them.
- K.T.: Moses' audience was the 12 tribes of Israel; Jesus' audience was the 12 disciples or the <u>NEW</u> people of God.
- C. Jesus' called for repentance which is a change of mind that results in a change of BEHAVIOR. Matthew 6:8 Don't be like them. . .
- D. Christ's true followers are to be different from PAGANS.
- 1. Pagans love their friends; Christians love their enemies ALSO.
- 2. Pagans babble in prayer; Christians speak to a heavenly FATHER.
- 3. Pagans seek material possessions; Christians seek God's KINGDOM.
- 4. Pagans do what is best for themselves; Christians do what is best for OTHERS.
- 5. Pagans WORRY about things; Christians PRAY about things.
- 6. Pagans seek for revenge; Christians are to extend MERCY.
- 7. Pagans walk the <u>BROAD</u> road; Christians walk the <u>NARROW</u> road.
- E. Christ's true followers are to be different from religious <u>PEOPLE</u>. Matthew 5:20 "But I warn you—unless your righteousness is better than the righteousness of the teachers of religious law and the Pharisees, <u>you will never enter the Kingdom of Heaven!</u>
- 1. Religious people make a show of PRAYER; Christians pray secretly.
- 2. Religious people make a show of <u>FASTING</u>; Christians fast secretly.
- 3. Religious people make a show of GIVING; Christians give secretly.
- 4. Religious people are filled with <u>PRIDE</u>; Christians are filled with <u>HUMILITY!</u>
- 5. Religious people wear a MASK; Christians are mask FREE.
- F.T.: Every major change in life is based on a <u>DECISION</u> to change.
